Easter (Pascha)

Pope Saint John Paul II once said “We are an Easter people.” In context he was referring to our faith being one of deep, holy and hope-filled convictions. We celebrate and serve and surrender to a God who came down to us and lived a life as we live and suffered and died for us and then rose from the dead. No other religion in the world can boast in this. Only Christianity. More precisely, God left us with a church He built and feeds everyday with His own flesh and blood in the Catholic and Orthodox church. A reminder of His love for us. Let it become a habit to change your atmosphere around you. This atmosphere of joy is contagious and will spread within all your spheres of influence..
